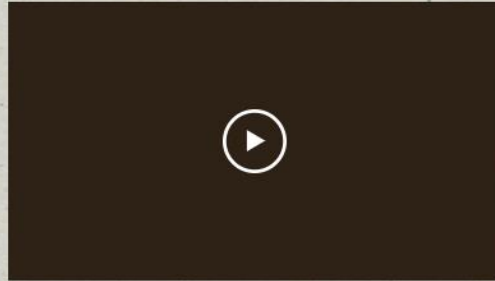

I am Okwaho Grimtotem adviser to the Redwood Tribes, Seer of the Earthen Ring, and speaker to the editor that writes these words.

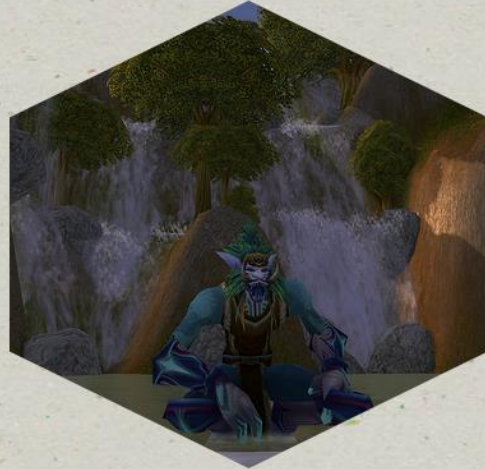
