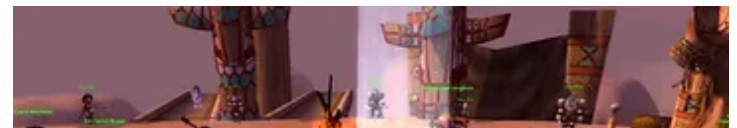
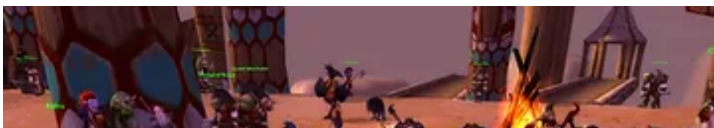

with the Bard of Bones

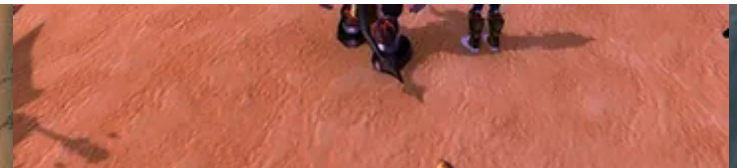
