*The Sage also received interesting Intel from Alliance – "Watch out for that Doug guy! He killed Hogger!" Now to decode the message...*

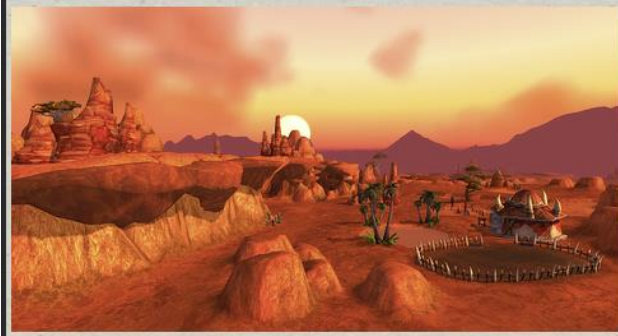

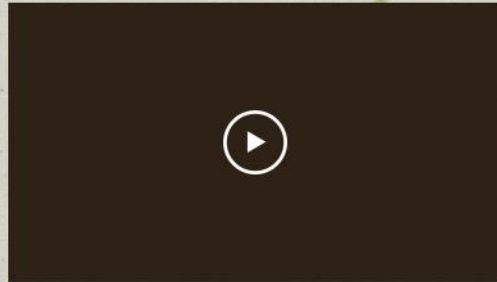

### Editor's Corner

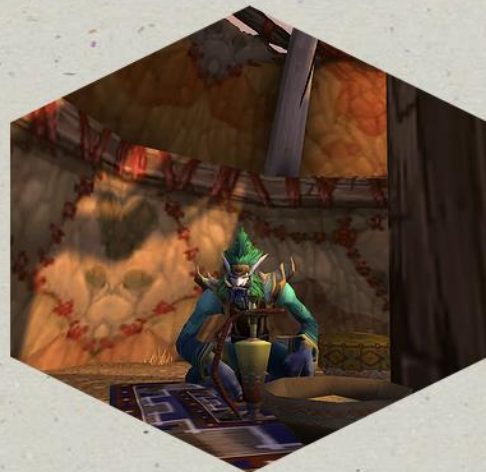
*I am Okwaho Grimtotem adviser to the Redwood Tribes, Seer of the Earthen Ring, and speaker to the editor that writes these words.*

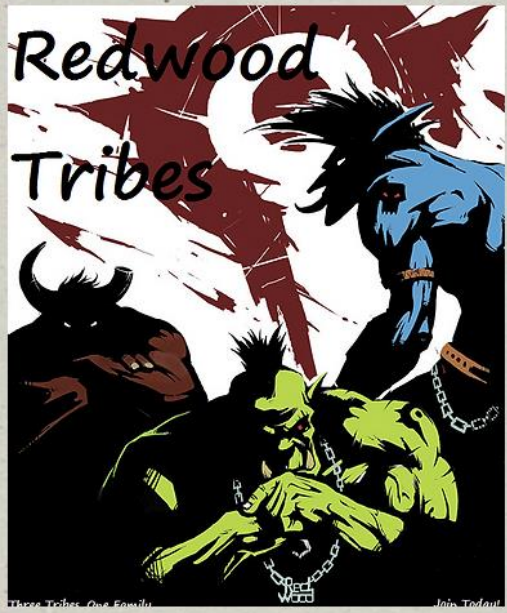
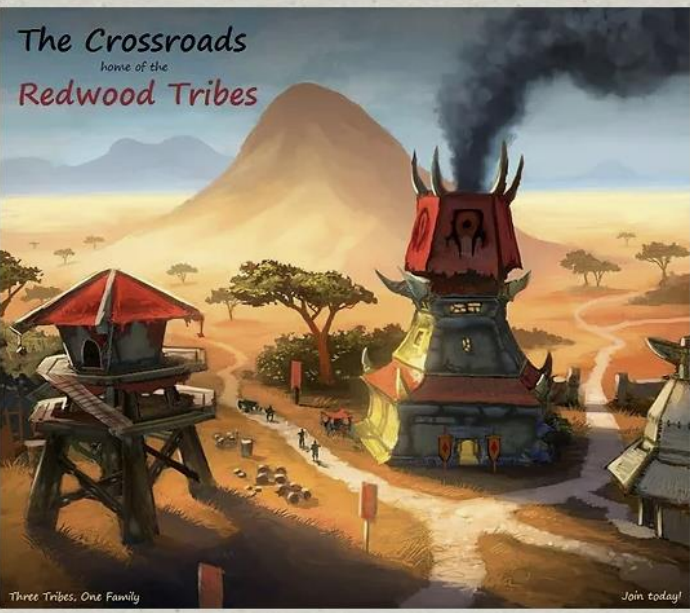
